- 4 Feel the shivers in their spines as Boyer tells dozens of eerie tales from such maritime locales as the Milwaukee Coast Guard station, Washington Island, Georgian Bay, Red Cliff, Port Huron, Whitefish Point, Escanaba, Isle Royale, and Batchawana Bay.

From missing ships to reappearing apparitions, Boyer introduces readers to a collection of tales that illuminate ancient and contemporary brushes with the supernatural in coastal communities along three Great Lakes: Lake Michigan, Lake Huron and Lake Superior.
